

Free Artwork & Photography Exhibit at Englewood Public Library in April



Award-winning digital artists **Jane Sklar** and **Max Cartagena** will display original artwork & photography at the Englewood Public Library during the month of April 2018. The exhibit will be in the Leonard Hansen Art Gallery on the library's main level. This exhibit is free and open to the public. No registration is needed.

The work produced from the duo is with a shared eye for the different and a disdain for the hyper-reality that Photoshop was designed to create. Those visiting the exhibit will get a tour of how things exist in Sklar and Cartagena's dream environment. Sklar explains her vision on photography as "reflecting a novel way of combining images to produce 'art paintings' by manipulating the images into layers, using the natural colors that editing programs bring out in the originals". The artwork produced is a life chronicle, and tells a very personal chapter in each piece.

Jane Sklar is an award-winning artist/photographer currently in Fort Lee, NJ. Since 2011, Sklar has teamed with her teacher and mentor Max Cartagena. They have each perfected a unique style of creating digitally generated artwork from original photographs.
